- Approximately 150-180 children benefited every month



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Re-constitution of National ASHA Mentoring Group (NAMG)-reg.

The National Rural Health Mission has been launched in 2005. In 2012, the National Urban Health Mission (NUHM) was conceptualized and the NRHM was rechristened as the National Health Mission (NHM) with the two Sub Missions viz. the NRHM and the NUHM.

Operationalization of the ASHA initiative is an important strategic intervention under the Mission. The Guidelines of the ASHA scheme have been drawn in consultation with the Task Group on ASHA. Further, 10 Public Health Professionals as non-official members of the Mission Steering Group (MSG) advice the Mission at the National level in policy and operations, including operationalization of ASHA scheme.


Accordingly, the Mentoring Group for ASHA was constituted in 2005 and subsequently reconstituted in 2009, 2012 and 2014. It has now been decided to further re-constitute a NAMG, which shall act as a Standing Technical Resource Group to assist the Central and State Governments in overall implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the ASHA scheme.


